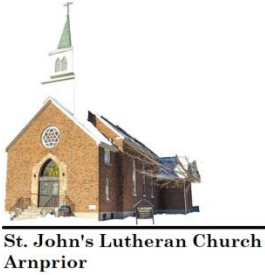

## Council Meeting Minutes

December 17, 2018

Randy Z opened with a prayer.

The minutes from the November 19, 2018 meeting were approved.

**Pastor's Report:** There was no pastor report as Pastor Norine was unable to attend.

### Financial Report:

- Profit & Losses versus what was budgeted was reviewed. Offerings are slightly up over budget, whereas expenses are slightly below budget. However, as of the date of the Council Meeting, current deficit is projected at around \$9,600.
- The Bazaar was successful in raising more than \$2300. A big thank you to all those who helped and participated in the Bazaar.
- There continues to be a need for a Room/Facility Rental Coordinator, as well as a Property Co-chair. Members of the congregation are asked to consider volunteering for these positions.

### Outreach/Community Report:

- A grand total of \$714 was raised for purchasing local, free-range chickens for the Food Bank – a truly generous congregation

### Marketing Report:

- Marketing will be asked to work with Council to develop a calendar of all the known planned events for this calendar year in advance of the Annual General Meeting.

### Council and Committee Membership:

- The date for the Annual General Meeting will be January 27, 2018.
- Members of the congregation are asked to consider leadership positions on the various committees, as well as on council. If members of the congregation have any questions, they can ask a council member.
